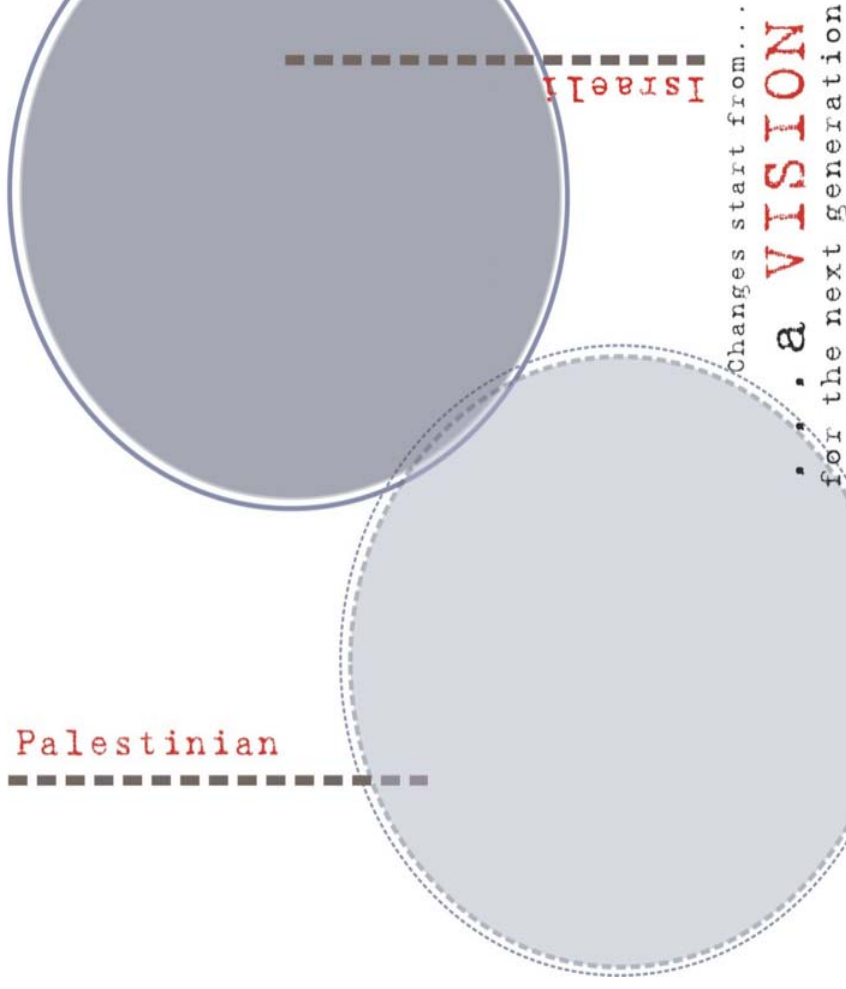


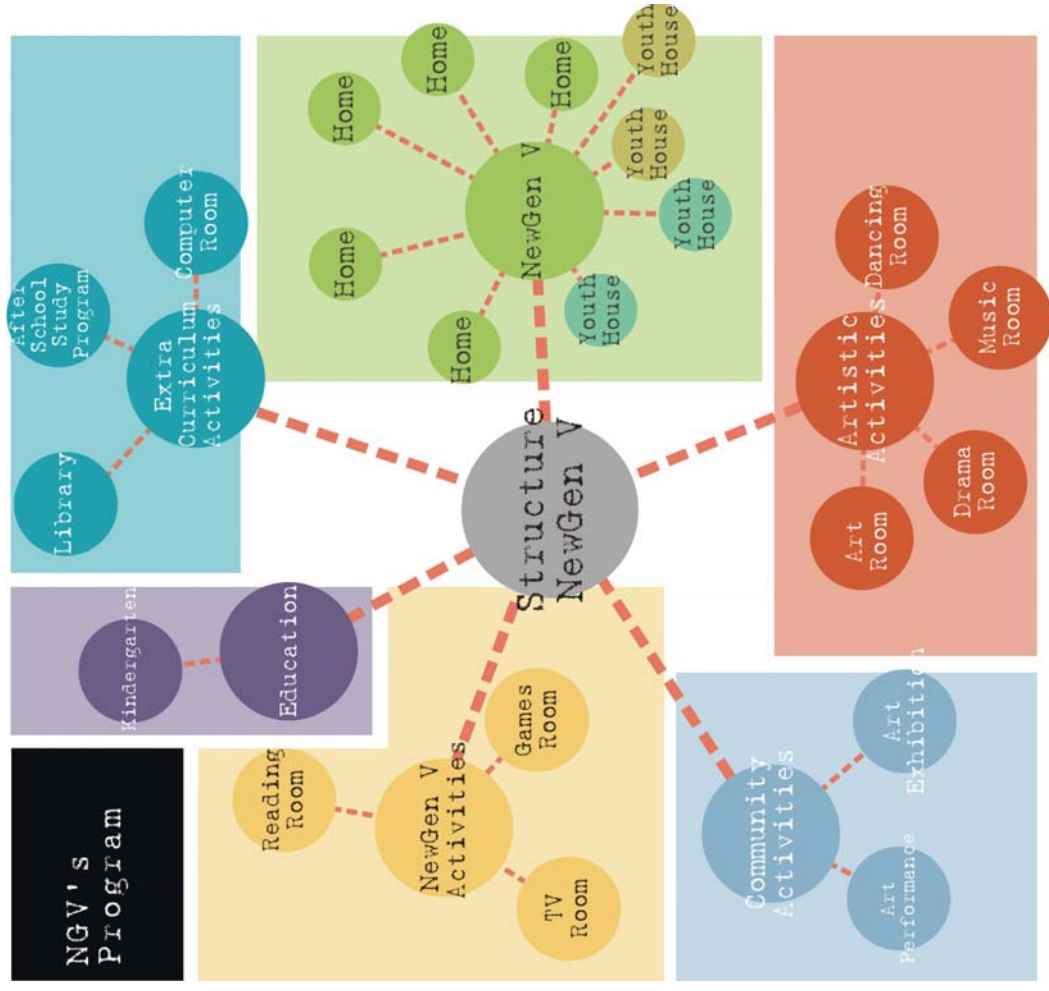
# <NewGen V> New Generation Village

giving it a new identity and a new future.

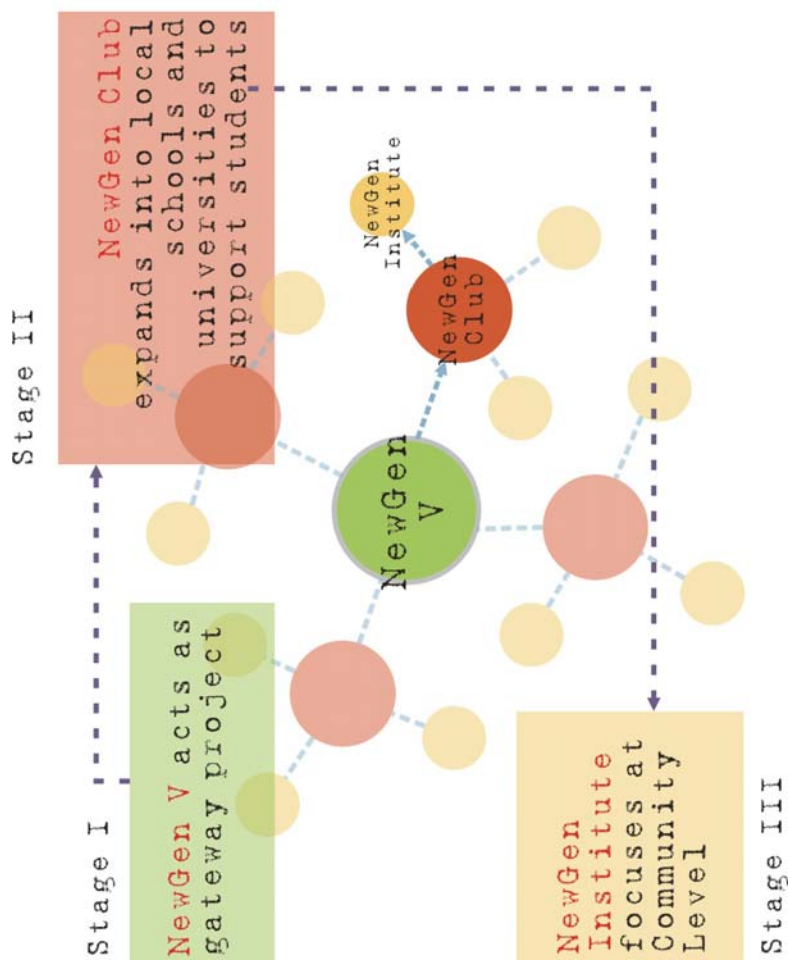
# <NewGen V>

is a residential & youth community co-existence project, which brings together "at-risk" Israeli and Palestinian youth between the ages of 0-18, in order to equip them to face future challenges through learned interdisciplinary skills. These youth may be from families without parents, with a single parent, or with parents who are unable to support them.



## Vision of <NewGen> movement

<NewGen V> acts not only as a model for co-existence in Jerusalem but also as a starting point, which will build the next generation of Israelis and Palestinians with a vision for living peacefully in the surrounding community, greater Jerusalem, and eventually, the whole nation.



The main focus of the project is **empowerment**.

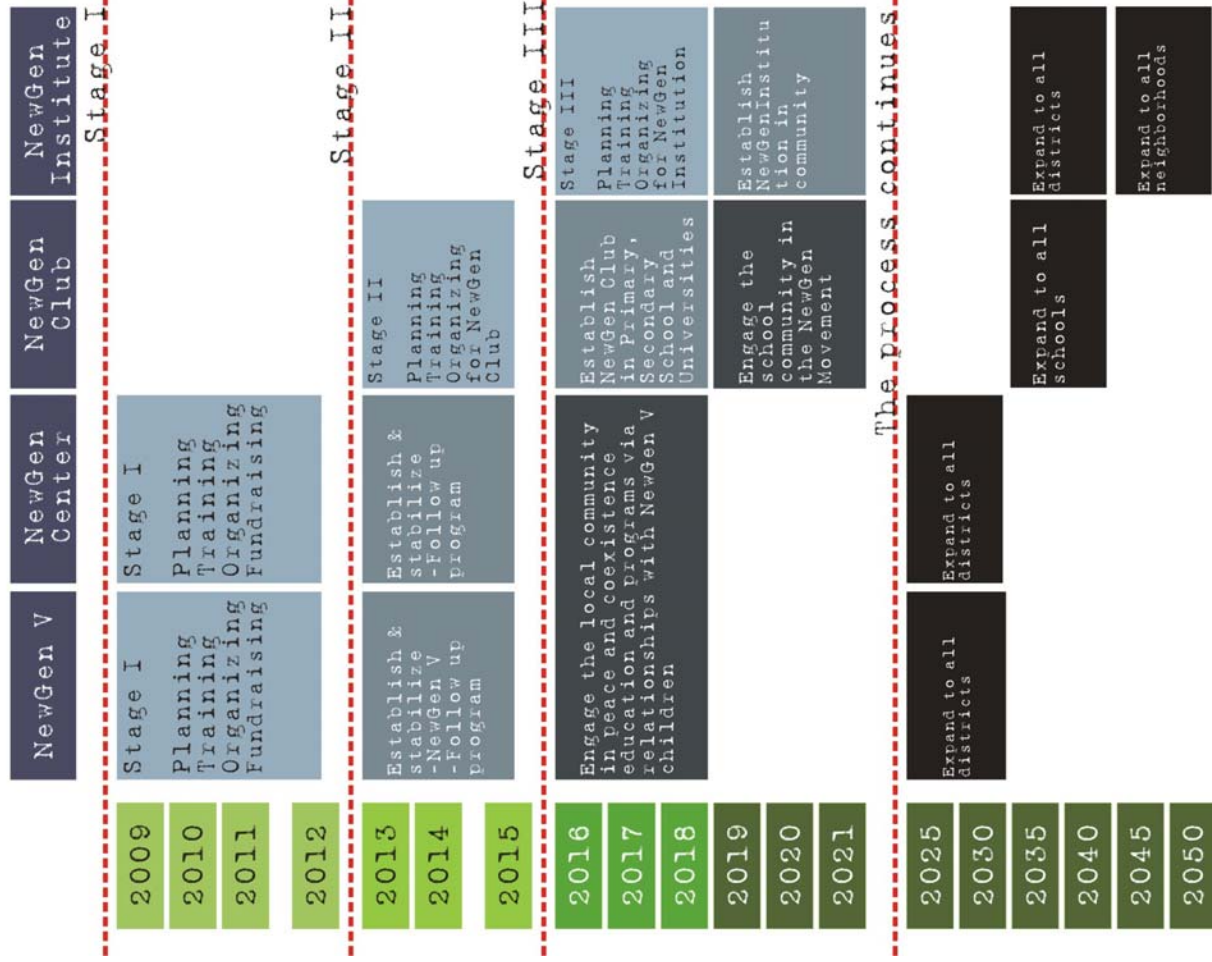
The new generation that is trained will actively engage others in the NewGen movement.
